2. Loess Bluffs Birding Hike

The National Wildlife Refuge Loess Bluffs is home to the largest stop over for Snow Geese in North America. Hike a moderately strenuous path through the loess hills with a 200-step staircase to the top of the bluffs & take a driving tour of the wetlands. You never know what you'll see!
